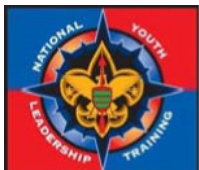

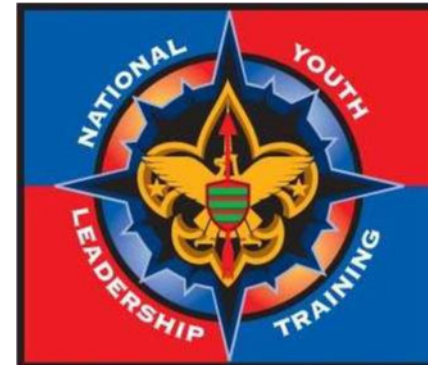

What is Silver Pines NYLT?

Silver Pines NYLT is a week-long outdoor experience for current and future troop leaders, utilizing the patrol method. It presents modern leadership skills that you will value throughout your life. These skills are presented in multiple formats providing opportunity for participants to live and practice these leadership skills. Training is conducted by an experienced youth staff (all previous participants). The course follows the BSA National Youth Leadership Training curriculum and provides life skills that can be used in school, work, life and of course your troop.

Who can attend?

Silver Pines is for you if you're a boy who can answer **YES** to **ALL** of the following:

- At least 13 years old by 26 December 2008
- **NOT** 18 years old before 31 December 2008
- At least a first class Scout by 26 December 2008
- Hold or intend to hold a troop leadership position
- Agree to practice the skills you learn after NYLT
- Do your best to live the scout oath and law
- Have week-long tent camp experience
- **Are mature and responsible enough to spend an entire week camping with boys you've never met, with minimal adult supervision**
- Your parents and Scoutmaster agree and recommend you

Why should I attend? [for Scouts]

- It's fun
- Leadership skills help you in scouting, school and life
- Leading your troop will be more fun
- Make new friends
- To learn, practice, teach and show off your leadership skills
- It's fun

Why should I send Scouts? [for Scoutmasters]

- We provide intensive leadership training in a controlled environment that would be difficult for you to reproduce
- Trained leaders make your job easier

How much does it cost?

- The NYLT Course Total Cost is \$200
- \$50 deposit is required with application

Council Activities Refund Policy

1. Refund request will only be considered in writing.
2. A service charge of 25% of the full activity fee will be assessed on all refunds to cover cost incurred in preparation of the activity and processing the refund.
3. Written refund request submitted after the activity will be considered only for personal illness or family emergencies. No refund requests will be accepted after 10 days following the end of the activity.
4. Consideration for full refund may be considered for special hardship cases and for advanced level training courses such as Wood Badge and Powder Horn
5. For major activities that require a non-refundable deposit, such as council contingents to the National Jamboree and Philmont, a full refund less the non-refundable deposit will be considered, based on the time of the request and the Council's ability to fill the slot with another participant.
6. Refund checks will be issued to the individual or entity paying the original fee within 30 days of receipt of the request pending approval.
7. Fees are only transferable within the same unit to a Scout or adult leader not currently registered for that specific activity.
8. If an activity is cancelled or postponed and the participant cannot participate during the alternate date, the full fee will be refunded.
