

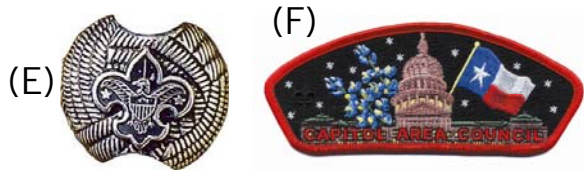


BOY SCOUT UNIFORM PRICE LIST
