In our on-going efforts to make your camp experience enjoyable and memorable, we have made a few improvements to our program this year. Here are just a few of the highlights:

- ◆ Smaller classes: we've reduced the class participant size and added more classes.
- ◆ Metalwork: we've added the foundry option.
- ◆ More time for certain

merit badges: we've extended the time for classes like small boat sailing and blacksmithing to allow more time for youth to hone their skills.

- ◆ Eagle Quest becomes a half-day program: your Scouts will still focus on rank requirements and swimming merit badge, but now they will be able to choose other merit badges in addition!
- ◆ An Eagle Quest Week! That's right, Week 4 will be just for our Eagle Quest campers focusing on rank and a select number of merit badges.

- ◆ A new COPE course! (We'll be sharing more details on that in later issues.)
