Our goal is to have all Recharter paperwork submitted to [Frank Fickett Scout Training and Service Center](#) by Monday November 30<sup>th</sup>. To assist you in an on time Recharter there are some things you can do right now that will help with completing your Recharter on time.

1. Reach out to your families and find out if they are planning to return in 2021. If they are not continuing please let your Unit Commissioner, District Commissioner or District Executive know! Details about the new fee structure can be found [HERE](#). Please remember that the Capitol Area Council is committed to providing every youth the opportunity to participate in Scouting. 2. Talk with your Chartered Org about the Recharter process. Find out if you can schedule a meeting with them this fall to review and sign paperwork and/or applications.
3. Identify your Units URL (Unit Recharter Leader) to support your units Recharter efforts this fall.
4. Bookmark the [CAC Recharter page](#) to stay up to date on Recharter news.

We realize that the uncertainty around COVID-19 might affect how you approach your annual Recharter process. Our Recharter team is working to review current practices and identify ways we make sure to practice social distancing when getting Recharter paperwork signed and turning it into the Fickett Center.
