

Unit Level Camping - Shooting Event
COVID Plan for Lost Pines Scout Reservation

At all Unit Level Camping events using the firearms ranges, the following procedures are required:

- a) Temperature checks will be conducted before entry onto the range;
 - The Temperature Log will be completed for all staff and participants, on the form prescribed in the Council's Guide to Conducting Events and Activities;
- b) Safety Protocols:
 - Social distancing of at least six (6) feet should be maintained between students;
 - Each activity will have at least one Event COVID Safety Officer to supervise and enforce the rules in this document, and those outlined in the Council Guide to Conducting Events and Activities (e.g., mask discipline, social distancing, sanitization protocols);
 - Face coverings must be properly worn by everyone, during both classroom and range operations;
 - The identification and appointment of 1-2 adults responsible for sanitizing firearms, benches, and eye and ear protection between shooters; and
 - All participants (including instructors) to bring their own lunch, water bottles and beverages, unless food is being provided by the unit;
- c) Equipment:
 - All participants will be encouraged to bring their own camp chairs;
 - All participants will be encouraged to bring their own eye and ear protection;
 - All firearms and shooting benches to be sanitized by instructors with Clorox/Lysol/alcohol wipes between shooters. In the absence of wipes, spray bottles and paper towels will be used;
 - All Council-provided eye and ear protection to be sanitized by instructors with Clorox/Lysol/alcohol wipes between shooters. In the absence of wipes, spray bottles and paper towels will be used; and
 - Hand sanitizer dispensers to be made available at the entry point on the range.
- d) Scheduling of shooters in blocks of no more than five (5) shooters per block:
 - On the Rifle Range, only every other shooting lane may be used.
 - On the Shotgun Range, all five (5) shooting positions may be used.
