#### **Medical Forms:**

Here are some Medical Form instructions from our lead Medic - Nick Rietsch

# Form A&B valid until 08/01/2023

- Form must be signed
- Emergency contact must be present
- Allowed adults for pick up/drop off: #1 a parent/guardian #2 the jambo troop SM
- Unit leader: Sully or jambo SM
- Allergies must be filled out
- Allowing over the counter medicine is highly recommended (ibuprofen for headache for example) and MUST BE SIGNED for youths
- Weight and heights are required on the form...this is a high adventure event

#### Form C

• Must be filled out correctly and with the doctor's office signature and address information (a stamp is acceptable)

# Forms A, B and C need be handed over manually to your Unit Medic (not sending by email) The National Jamboree Risk Advisory to Health-Care Providers and Parents

 Must be handed over to Nick Rietsch, Ida Murguia or Betsy Shelton AFTER having been uploaded to the Jambo website.

# **Upload link**

- You will receive a new email with a new upload link every 2 weeks from Jamboree National.
- The link is specific to your scout and cannot be shared with other scouts.
- June 19 is the last day to upload Medical Forms to have them Pre-checked.

After that your scout and a buddy will have to go stand in line at checkin to have theirs reviewed and approved.

Always pack your own hardcopies of Medical forms, Rafting Waivers, Swim Checks, other forms your filled out and Training Certificates (Adults) just in case. After all, a scout is prepared. Swim Check:

• All scouts must have a Swim Check if they are going to participate in any aquatics activities

at the Jamboree (**Kafting**, Kayaking, Canoeing, Paddle Boarding, ...)

• You will need to have your swim check with your local unit. If they cannot provide one, there are alternatives. Reach out to:

Betsy Shelton (Bluebonnets)

• The Local unit will need to provide evidence of the swim check status.
